Brian, a onetime commercial grower of roses, adapted his "soft-handed" horticultural technique to his wine grapes. Since 2008, Brian and his family have tended Bella Vista Vineyard in the Pompadour Bluff area east of Ashland planted to Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon. The vines, now twenty-five years-old, have yielded exquisite fruit under Jordaan's care.

The just-released Cabernet Sauvignon is fullbodied, showing flavors of currants, dark cherry and sandalwood—a beautifully balanced vintage with 30 months in barrel. Jordaan has added a neighboring vineyard, Thistlecroft, a wellestablished vineyard, producing Tempranillo, Merlot and Cabernet Franc. The Tempranillo offers a lush mélange of aromas and flavors featuring ripe strawberry and dark cherry notes. New to the lineup is an exquisite Cabernet Franc Blanc, an elegant tropical wine with a beautiful mouth feel. Eliana Wines has earned numerous gold medals at prestigious nationwide competitions.

Brian and Carien believe that wine is to be enjoyed with friends and loved ones, is something to gather around, to experience life together with, and to create lasting memories. 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

WEISINGER FAMILY WINERY was first planted in 1978 by John Weisinger and is one of the oldest vineyards in the Rogue Valley. The winery, established 10 years after the vineyard was planted in 1988, was one of the first wineries in the region to begin producing wine. The tasting room is the first one that visitors will encounter upon entering Oregon on Interstate 5 after descending Siskiyou Summit. With fruit sourced from local vineyards, many managed by the Weisinger family, the wines are made by second-generation winemaker, and owner, Eric Weisinger.

Be sure to try their award-winning, and soughtafter, Estate Tempranillo along with Grenache, Malbec and Cabernet Franc. And don't miss the whites—Roussanne, Viognier and Sauvignon Blanc, the latter being a specialty of Eric's from many years working in the Marlborough Region of New Zealand.

Whether tasting wine in the intimate tasting room or relaxing on one of the spacious decks with amazing views of the rugged Cascade mountain range in the distance, Weisinger Family Winery is the perfect place to relax and savor a glass of truly Southern Oregon craft wine.

Local visual artists are featured monthly in the tasting room. And don't forget about their unique Vineyard Cottage that's available for overnight stays— the perfect place for a romantic weekend or just the spot to relax and enjoy a vineyard getaway!






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

Owners Ross and Jen Allen take pride in 2Hawk's quality wine, genuine hospitality, and dedicated site stewardship. Sustainability practices are employed throughout the property to protect the land and conserve resources. The state-of-the-art winery is topped with solar panels and was constructed using green building techniques. In the vineyard, special sensors optimize irrigation for the best grapes while preserving water.

At the 2Hawk tasting room, pair excellent wine with chef-prepared food options including flatbreads, artisan cheeses, and charcuterie. Enjoy the ambiance of the tasting room with its elegant fieldstone walls and reclaimed timber, or venture outside for a game of bocce ball and sweeping views of the Siskiyou mountains and vineyards. Umbrellas and covered seating shade the sun, while heaters and firepits warm chilly evenings.



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

EDENVALE WINERY is one of the Rogue Valley's top destinations. Located just off Hwy 99 between Ashland and Jacksonville, the winery and tasting room is sited on the oldest commercial orchard land in Oregon. Relax and enjoy panoramic views of the Siskiyou mountains and surrounding orchards and vineyards.

The Eden Valley Orchards property takes you back to an era of gracious hospitality with the on-site 1890's Voorhies Mansion, formal gardens, heritage pear trees and a demonstration vineyard. The winery and tasting room feature a wide range of barrelaged red wines, crisp whites and ciders made from estate-grown pears, all handcrafted by winemaker Ashley Campanella. Many of the varietals are small lot bottlings and are highly sought-after by discerning wine drinkers. Summer of 2022, we begin our adventure in distilled products.

The tasting room is open daily and offers numerous small and private gathering spaces for tasting and flight options as well as pairing food menu and gift merchandise. Just minutes from anywhere in the Rogue Valley, the access is easy and close to all major roads and highways.

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

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ROXYANN WINERY was originally the pear growing and packing operation known as Hillcrest Orchard. But Jack Day, grandson of the Seattle businessman who became owner and manager of Hillcrest in 1908, had other ideas. Day planted wine grapes on 20 acres of the south-facing slope of RoxyAnn Peak where shallow clay soils are perfect for Bordeaux varietals. With the first harvest in 2001, RoxyAnn Winery was born.

Today the RoxyAnn estate vineyard runs to 70 acres from which the winery produces 15,000 cases of award-winning Claret, Pinot Gris, Sauvignon Blanc, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Tempranillo, Viognier, Syrah, Pinot Noir, and Chardonnay. Recently, their 2018 Petite Sirah was awarded Double-Gold at the 2022 San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition! Many of the original Hillcrest Orchard buildings, added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1984, are still used by the winery. Visitors will enjoy the warm, old-fashioned atmosphere of the tasting room featuring premium estate wines and gourmet items. The quaint setting notwithstanding, RoxyAnn adheres to enlightened sustainable farming practices and employs state-of-theart methods in wine production, supporting preservation of the natural surroundings while ensuring the finest fruit and superior wines. The tasting room is open seven days a week.

CLIFF CREEK CELLARS' 230+ acre Sam's Valley Vineyard is located in the heart of Southern Oregon's wine region, just northeast of Gold Hill. This family-owned farm has been farmed for many years by the Garvin family and is also used to graze cattle and grow grass, hay, and alfalfa. CCC is a family-friendly vineyard that's easily accessible from I-5, making for a great place to stop for wine tasting after hiking, rafting, or fishing the Upper Rogue River. No matter what your outdoor fun is in this picturesque valley, Cliff Creek is nearby as an end-of-day oasis.

Taking advantage of the warmth and sunlight, 70 acres is planted to Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Sangiovese, and Syrah. Events and the beautiful setting are not the only reasons to visit as Cliff Creek boasts a lineup of award-winning wines. Their most recent medals include a Best in Class for their 2017 Syrah and Double Gold medal for the 2020 Red Red Wine from the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition, along with a host of other golds and silvers for their Claret, Cabernet Sauvignon, MRV and Cabernet Franc at the McMinnville Wine Classic and the Oregon Wine Competition.

DEL RIO VINEYARDS is both a place deeply rooted in history and a winery reflecting the latest in viticulture and enology. The tasting room was built in 1864 and served for many years as the Rock Point Stage Hotel. The parcel of land that comprises one of the largest wine-growing operations in the Rogue Valley was originally a pear orchard, and the big red building displaying the Del Rio name that today houses the winery began as the fruit packinghouse of Del Rio Orchards.

Del Rio's estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Malbec, Merlot, Muscat, Pinot Gris, Pinot Noir, Syrah and Viognier, reflect the time-honored traditions of Old World winemaking blended with New World innovation by head winemaker Jean-Michel Jussiaume. In addition to the Estate brand, Del Rio crafts two other wine brands: Jolee Wines & Rock Point Wines. The semi-sparkling Jolee Rosé is Oregon's favorite rosé with its hint of sweetness and bubbles. The Rock Point Wines reflect our heart for adventuring in Oregon—all five wines are approved for everyday sipping.

Awen focuses on "off the beaten path" varietals, such as Grenache Blanc, Vermentino, and Dolcetto, as well as some more popular varietals in the area, like Tempranillo and Viognier. Awen has won numerous awards for their wines in Oregon and nationwide. Visit them and get a taste of what they call, "Local Liquid Poetry."





DAISY CREEK VINEYARD owner Russ Lyon came to Jacksonville in 1994 with his wife, Margaret, looking for a place similar to the Northern Rhone Valley's famous Côte Rotie, (roasted slope) the perfect place to grow Syrah and Viognier. On a 23-acre tract where fortuneseekers once panned Daisy Creek for gold, the Lyons planted a couple of acres of vines. Thanks in large part to the mineral-laden soils washed down from the Siskiyou Mountains by the creek, and in larger part to the hard work of the couple tending the vines, the fruit they're growing turned out to be good—really good.

Today the vineyard occupies over half of the property and produces seven wine grape varietals that include Chardonnay, Viognier, Marsanne, Roussanne, Malbec, Syrah and Petit Verdot.

Virtually all the single vintage varietals have won medals at competitions including San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition and Oregon Wine Experience. This season, Russ tells us to look for the release of this very popular 2021 Syrah Rosé along with his smooth and silky 2019 Chardonnay and our popular 2019 Triple Play White Blend!

Daisy Creek Vineyard offers visitors a casual tasting room experience, and staff are delighted to point-out the location of a slurry mine, a reminder of the old-timers who came seeking gold. Most of them never found any. Margaret and Russ certainly did.

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QUADY NORTH's tasting room is located on their organically-certified vineyard and winery site, just outside of Ruch in the Applegate Valley. In early 2022, they consolidated their tasting room and winery at the vineyard site that opened in March.

Quady North is the name of Herb Quady's Applegate Valley wine venture, a scion of his parents' Fresno area Quady Winery. QN is known for big, bold Bordeaux and Rhone varietals. After working as Assistant Winemaker at the California Central Coast Bonny Doon Vineyard, Herb came to Oregon to found his own brand, convinced that the truly-compelling wines were being made from grapes grown in cooler areas.

In 2005, the family planted their first 15 acres of Syrah, Cabernet Franc and Viognier on an Applegate Valley hillside. Today, the list of varietals has expanded to include Grenache, Grenache Blanc, Marsanne, Roussanne, Malbec, and Mourvèdre. They have also begun producing wines under the "Layne Vineyard" label, honoring that historic Applegate site, first planted by the Laynes in 1973. This line includes old vine Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay and Merlot.

Quady North wines have been named as one of the world's Top 100 by leading wine publications three times over the last 10 years, including as recently as 2021. The tasting room features views of the vineyard and Applegate Valley, with indoor and outdoor seating. Small bites and gourmet cheese and charcuterie plates are available.



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Tasting Terms:

While you're out enjoying your favorite vineyards' offerings, these terms will come in handy!

Brix: A measurement of the sugar content of grapes, indicating the degree of the grapes' ripeness at harvest. Most wine grapes are harvested at between 21 and 25 Brix. For an alcohol conversion level, multiply the stated Brix by .55.

Chaptalization: The addition of sugar to juice before and/or during fermentation, to boost sugar levels in under-ripe grapes and alcohol levels in the subsequent wines.

Canopy: The parts of the grapevine above ground including shoots and leaves.

Clone: A group of vines originating from a single, individual plant propagated asexually from a single source. Clones are selected for the unique qualities of the grapes and wines they yield, such as flavor, productivity and adaptability to growing conditions.

Crush: The time during harvest season when the grapes are picked and crushed.

Early Harvest: Denotes a wine made from early-harvested grapes, usually lower than average in alcohol content or sweetness.

Fermentation: The process by which yeast converts sugar into alcohol and carbon dioxide and turns grape juice into wine.

Field Blend: When a vineyard is planted to several varieties harvested together to produce a single wine.

Filtering: The process of removing particles from wine after fermentation. Most wines, unless otherwise labeled, are filtered for both clarity and stability.

Green Harvest: The trimming of unripe grapes to decrease crop yields, thereby improving the concentration of the remaining bunches.

Late Harvest: On labels, indicates that a wine was made from grapes picked later than normal and at a higher sugar (Brix) level than normal.

Lees: Sediment remaining in a barrel or tank during and after fermentation.

Maceration: During fermentation, the steeping of the grape skins and solids in the wine, where alcohol acts as a solvent to extract color, tannin and aroma from the skins.

MOG: Material other than grape.

Must: The unfermented juice of grapes extracted by crushing or pressing.

Passerillage: French term for leaving grapes on the vine past normal harvest so they dry-up and concentrate their flavors.

Pip: Grape seeds.

Press Wine: The juice extracted under pressure after pressing for white wines and after fermentation for reds. Press wine has more flavor and aroma, deeper color and often more tannins than free-run juice.

Racking: The practice of moving wine by hose from one container to another, leaving sediment behind for purposes of aeration or clarification.

Ripeness: The point when a grape has achieved a sufficient balance of sugars and acids.

Scion: A producer vine and the part of a vine that is grafted onto rootstock and from which wine grapes will be harvested.

Tannin: The mouth-puckering substance found mostly in red wines derived primarily from grape skins, seeds and stems, but also from oak barrels. Tannin acts as a natural preservative that helps wine age and develop.

Veraison: The stage in the annual growth cycle of a grapevine where the grapes ripen and change color.

Vine Density: The number of vines per acre.

Vintage Date: Indicates the year that a wine was made. In order to carry a vintage date in the United States, a wine must come from grapes that are at least 95 percent from the stated calendar year.

Viticultural Area: A legally-defined grapegrowing area distinguished by geographical features, climate, soil, elevation, history and other definable boundaries.

Vintner-Grown: Wine from a wineryowned vineyard situated outside the winery's delimited viticultural area.

Yeast: Micro-organisms that produce the enzymes which convert sugar to alcohol and are necessary for the fermentation of grape juice into wine.

Yield: The quantity of fruit a parcel of land renders after a harvest.


